#### APPROVE AMENDMENT #2, HOBBY AREA BUS SHELTERS PROJECT

Mr. Lowry reported that staff requested additional services from Clark Condon as it relates to the Hobby Area Bus Shelters Project. He stated Clark Condon needs additional construction administration due to time delays, permitting, and construction issues. Mr. Lowry stated that this additional funding will be recovered from Contractor penalties, and therefore, he recommended amendment #2 for approval.

Following review and discussion, Director Collum made a motion to approve Amendment #2 as presented. Director Amin seconded the motion, which passed by unanimous vote.





### COMMITTEE & STAFF ACTIVITY

# **Community Development**

- In efforts to maintain our bus shelter vibrant, we are inquiring with NEC to update the existing panels with a polycarbonate double panel that will sandwich the graphics. By doing so, this will help prevent the graphics that each bus shelter occupies from being tampered with. The District's first step is to replace the panels that are currently vandalized as opposed to completely replacing all panels. Currently this project is estimated at \$45,160. The Bellfort Station RFP asked for a bold vision with a series of projects to transform the Hobby area. As a practical matter, the vision must be achievable with a roadmap of improvements SWA and staff have held a series of meetings with TXDoT and the City of Houston seeking buy in and as a strategy for each entity to consider funding and engineering before next fiscal year. Both entities were open to the ideas and selected representatives to participate in the advisory committee.
- ➤ So far this year, the Special Projects Crew picked up 6,500 lbs. of trash along 244.8 miles of right-of-way, removed 689 bandit signs, and mowed 55.2 miles of right-of-way throughout the District. The Landscaping Crew watered newly planted trees, removed 11 bandit signs, picked up 5,750

- lbs. of trash and yard waste, and weeded the medians on Broadway Street. The Gulf Freeway Crew picked up 1,200 lbs. of trash, 3 bandit signs, and mowed 4.83 miles of right-of-way on the south-bound right-of-way along I-45
- ➤ I-45 Pilot Project The District has secured three bids and presented to Houston First for the cost of maintenance of the I-45 corridor from Hobby to Greater East End District. TXDoT has agreed to fund a portion of the project if each of the Districts will participate. The next step is for Houston First to call a meeting with all of the districts to present the proposed cost and seek "buy in." Pending action by Houston First.


# **Economic Development**

- Business Networking Breakfasts The monthly business networking breakfasts returned in January, sponsored by Powell Industries with Bryant Henderson speaking to Comcast's effort to upgrade its fiber network. February's breakfast will be sponsored by CenterPoint Energy and the speaker will be Pedro Chavez with Workforce Solutions on programs small businesses can utilize to attract a quality workforce
- > Assistance issues are created when an area business contacts the District for help. In 2017, the District received 18 requests for assistance—15 closed and 3 pending, with an average of 109 days open. In 2018, the District has received 30 requests for assistance—29 closed and 1 open issues with an average of 31 days open.
- ➤ With approval from the board in this year's budget, we have executed a contract with Aaron Farm at Retail Coach to undertake a retail strategic plan. Retail is one of our targeted industries and the study will be used to identify types of appropriate retail for attraction efforts.
- As a follow up to meetings between the District, SWA, City of Houston, and TxDOT regarding the Reverie and Telephone exchange for the Bellfort Station project a traffic count was conducted through SWA. The results support our position on the alignment. However, SWA has devised a third alternative in the alignment we feel will be more amenable to TxDOT. The next step is to conduct a traffic engineering study. We are waiting for the proposal on this study.
- When Hobby Area Management District staff work with a business for the purposes of economic development a project is initiated and fall into one of three categories—attraction, retention, and expansion. If the company does not currently exist in the District it is an attraction project. If the company is in the District but considering relocating it is a retention project. If the company is in the District and plans to add capacity, facilities, or workforce it is an expansion project. To date, the District has worked on 25 projects (22 attraction, 1 expansion and 2 retention).

### **Public Safety**

- ➤ Received updates from SEAL Security on patrol activities in the District. Written reports are provided to the committee and posted on the District's website. SEAL Security has assisted in several site specific "surge" operations which have helped reduce vice and drug related activities along the airport corridors. There were educational, enforcement, and human traffic rescue aspects of the program. The project was repeated during the holiday season.
- ➤ The HPD PIP meeting for the apartment community continues to meet and build participation. District staff and Tina DeFiore, HAA, RCR Director, help organize and keep the meetings on track, but various apartment communities are providing the lunches and HPD is providing the presentations. On average about 25 people representing 9 different communities are regularly participating.
- ➤ The Hobby Area District contracts with the Greater East End Management District (GEEMD) to conduct a weekly survey along major thoroughfares or specific areas as directed by staff. Subsequently, GEEMD reports identified issues to the appropriate agency for action. To date, 788 issues have been reported with 96.8% closed in an average of 34 days. The following is a breakout of each issue category by its status:

### SUMMARY OF TEXAS OPEN MEETINGS ACT REQUIREMENTS

### Texas Open Meetings Act ("TOMA")

The Texas Open Meetings Act (Chapter 551, Texas Government Code) requires each elected or appointed public official to complete a course of training of not less than one and not more than two hours regarding the responsibilities of the governmental body and its members under the TOMA.

### **DEADLINES FOR TRAINING**

• Elected or appointed directors who have taken the oath of office must complete the requisite training within 90 days of taking the oath of office.

### How to Receive TOMA Training

### Option 1: Watch the Training Video Online

The Texas Attorney General website provides a link to its TOMA training materials. The link will open a Windows Media file that will run for just over 1 hour. If you do not have high-speed internet access, viewing this file may be difficult. The link is available at:

### Option 2: Request Materials from the Office of the Texas Attorney General

You may obtain a <u>free</u> DVD copy of the training material by calling the Attorney General's Public Information and Assistance line at 1-800-252-8011. VHS copies are not available.

Upon completion of training, a certificate of completion is required to be filed with the District's records manager (in most cases, ABHR). You may obtain the certificate from the Attorney General's Office in the following ways:

SUMMARY OF TEXAS PUBLIC INFORMATION ACT REQUIREMENTS.

### Texas Public Information Act ("TPIA")

Chapter 552, Government Code also requires Board members to receive Attorney General-approved training on the Texas Public Information Act.

Each director must receive TPIA training within the same time frames as the TOMA training or designate the District's record keeper, as the District's public information coordinator, to obtain TPIA training on his or her behalf. TPIA training materials may be obtained from the Attorney General's office in the same manner as the TOMA materials.

In most cases, ABHR has been designated as the District's public information coordinator. ABHR's attorneys, legal assistants, and administrative assistants have received TPIA training and copies of certificates of TPIA training are available upon request.

If a district has not designated ABHR as its public information coordinator, each director must receive TPIA training.

### MEMORANDUM

RE: Conflict of Interest Disclosure

All local government officers and vendors (as those terms are defined below) must comply with the disclosure requirements of Chapter 176 of the Local Government Code. The disclosure requirements of Chapter 176 are in addition to any other disclosures required by law.

In general, a local government officer must disclose if he/she has a current business relationship (as that term is defined below) with any vendor (contractor or consultant) doing business with the local government entity if that relationship results in either: (i) gifts to the officer or the officer's immediate family in excess of \$100 (including entertainment, lodging and travel; but NOT including food or beverage accepted as a guest) OR (ii) an employment or any other business relationship that results in \$2,500 of taxable income (other than investment income) in the previous 12-month period. Also, a local government officer must disclose any family relationship with a vendor of the local government entity. Set forth below is a summary of the disclosure requirements of Chapter 176.

\* \* \*

### I. DISCLOSURE BY LOCAL GOVERNMENT OFFICER

### A. Relationships Requiring Disclosure

A local government officer shall file a conflicts disclosure statement (Texas Ethics Commission Form CIS, a copy of which is attached to this memorandum) with respect to a vendor if:

1. The vendor has contracted with the local governmental entity or the local governmental entity is considering doing business with the vendor;

### **AND**

### 2. The vendor:

a. has (1) an employment or other business relationship with the local government officer or a family member of the officer (2) that results in the officer or family member receiving taxable income (other than investment income) in excess of \$2,500 in the preceding 12-month period; (FORM CIS – Section 4)

### OR

b. has a family relationship with the local government officer; (FORM CIS—Section 4)<sup>1</sup>

### OR

c. has given to the local government officer or a family member of the officer one or more gifts, including entertainment, lodging, and travel accepted as a guest (EXCEPTION: gifts of food or beverage accepted as a guest) that have an aggregated value of more than \$100 in the preceding 12-month period. (FORM CIS – Section 5)<sup>2</sup>

<u>GIFT EXCEPTION</u>: the term gift does not include a benefit offered on account of kinship or a personal, professional, or business relationship independent of the official status of the recipient.

### B. Nature and Timing of Disclosure

The conflicts disclosure statement shall be made on Texas Ethics Commission FORM CIS and shall be filed with the records administrator of the local governmental entity not later than the seventh business day after the officer becomes aware of the facts that require the filing of the statement.

### C. Consequences for Failing to Disclose

It is an offense if an officer *knowingly* violates these requirements. The penalties for such offenses are:

- a Class C misdemeanor if the contract amount is less than \$1 million or if there is no contract amount for the contract:
- a Class B misdemeanor if the contract amount is at least \$1 million but less than \$5 million; or
- a Class A misdemeanor if the contract amount is at least \$5 million.

It is an exception to the application of Ch. 176 if the officer filed the required statement not later than the seventh business day after the officer receives notice of the violation from the local government entity.

### II. DISCLOSURE BY VENDORS

All vendors of the local government entity are also required to file conflict of interest questionnaires (Texas Ethics Commission Form CIQ, a copy of which is attached to this memorandum) with respect to the local government entity.

### III. MAINTENANCE OF RECORDS

Each district must maintain a list of local government officers of the local governmental entity and shall make that list available to the public and any vendor who may be required to file a conflict of interest form. Additionally, districts are required to maintain a file of any completed CIQ or CIS form received by the district. Moreover, if the district maintains a website, the district must post any completed CIQ or CIS forms to the district's website.

### III. <u>DEFINITIONS</u>

1. "Local governmental entity" includes a county, municipality, school district, water district, or other political subdivision of this state or a local government corporation, board, commission, district, or authority to which a member is appointed by a county or a municipality (including TIRZs).

- 2. "Local government officer" means a member of the governing body of a local governmental entity or a director, superintendent, administrator, president, or other person designated as the executive officer of a local governmental entity. The term also includes an agent of a local governmental entity who exercises discretion in the planning, recommending, selecting, or contracting of a vendor.
- 3. "Vendor" means a person who enters or seeks to enter into a contract with a local governmental entity. The term includes an agent of a vendor.
- 4. "Family member" means a person related to another person within the first degree by consanguinity or affinity (i.e., spouse, parents, or children of a person).
- 5. "Family relationship" means a relationship between a person and another person within the third degree of consanguinity or the second degree of affinity. The third degree of consanguinity extends to parents, children, grandchildren, siblings, grandparents, great grandchildren, nieces/nephews, aunts/uncles, and great grandparents; the second degree of affinity extends to spouses, parent-in-laws, and daughter/son-in-laws. Of note, step relationships are considered to be the same as blood relationships in determining such relationships.
- 6. "Gift" means a benefit offered by a person, including food, lodging, transportation, and entertainment accepted as a guest. The term does not include a benefit offered on account of kinship or a personal, professional, or business relationship independent of the official status of the recipient.
- 7. "Business relationship" means a connection between two or more parties based on commercial activity of one of the parties. The term does not include a connection based on:
- (A) a transaction that is subject to rate or fee regulation by a federal, state, or local governmental entity or an agency of a federal, state, or local governmental entity;
  - (B) a transaction conducted at a price and subject to terms available to the public; or
- (C) a purchase or lease of goods or services from a person that is chartered by a state or federal agency and that is subject to regular examination by, and reporting to, that agency.
- 8. "Investment income" means dividends, capital gains, or interest income generated from:

- (A) a personal or business:
  - (i) checking or savings account;
  - (ii) share draft or share account; or
  - (iii) other similar account;
- (B) a personal or business investment; or
- (C) a personal or business loan.
- 9. "Records administrator" means the director, county clerk, municipal secretary, superintendent, or other person responsible for maintaining the records of the local governmental entity.

### Local Government Code § 176.003(a)(2)(A) and (B):

- (a) A local government officer shall file a conflicts disclosure statement with respect to a vendor if:
  - (2) the vendor:
    - (A) has an employment or other business relationship with the local government officer or a family member of the officer that results in the officer or family member receiving taxable income, other than investment income, that exceeds \$2,500 during the 12-month period preceding the date that the officer becomes aware that
      - (i) a contract between the local governmental entity and vendor has been executed; or
      - (ii) the local governmental entity is considering entering into a contract with the vendor:
    - (B) has given to the local government officer or a family member of the officer one or more gifts that have an aggregate value of more than \$100 in the 12-month period preceding the date the officer becomes aware that:
      - (i) a contract between the local governmental entity and vendor has been executed; or
      - (ii) the local governmental entity is considering entering into a contract with the vendor.

### Local Government Code § 176.006(a) and (a-1)

- (a) A vendor shall file a completed conflict of interest questionnaire if the vendor has a business relationship with a local governmental entity and:
  - (1) has an employment or other business relationship with a local government officer of that local governmental entity, or a family member of the officer, described by Section 176.003(a)(2)(A);
  - (2) has given a local government officer of that local governmental entity, or a family member of the officer, one or more gifts with the aggregate value specified by Section 176.003(a)(2)(B), excluding any gift described by Section 176.003(a-1); or
  - (3) has a family relationship with a local government officer of that local governmental entity.
- (a-1) The completed conflict of interest questionnaire must be filed with the appropriate records administrator not later than the seventh business day after the later of:
  - (1) the date that the vendor:
    - (A) begins discussions or negotiations to enter into a contract with the local governmental entity; or
    - (B) submits to the local governmental entity an application, response to a request for proposals or bids, correspondence, or another writing related to a potential contract with the local governmental entity; or
  - (2) the date the vendor becomes aware:
    - (A) of an employment or other business relationship with a local government officer, or a family member of the officer, described by Subsection (a);
    - (B) that the vendor has given one or more gifts described by Subsection (a); or
    - (C) of a family relationship with a local government officer.


